I thought that this was going to be the first year (since being in the ministry) that we would not be sending out cards since we are not making a trip to the U.S. before Christmas. Then last night we found out that some dear friends (that have been reaching out to the Tarahumara Indians by translating the Bible into their native language) that live two hours from us will be heading to the states soon so we as a family spent the day hustling to write this letter and get the cards ready since Mark will be leaving early tomorrow morning to deliver them.

Well this year went by very quickly for us despite the Covid-19 which has incurred many inconveniences as I'm sure many of you have encountered, such as lost of fellowship with family and friends, spiritual uplifting, adjusting school and work schedules, and other things that demanded ones attention. Crystal and Cassandra because of our electricity going out so often and the internet being so slow decided to spend the majority of their last two semesters at our rented home in Chihuahua City while Daniel, because of wanting to work on vehicle repairs, decided to remain with us here in San Juanito; which of course is a huge blessing for us. We know that in time our children will move out to accomplish what God is leading them to do, but until then we continue to cherish each and every moment we have with them!

Crystal and Cassandra passed seventh semester in the Medical Program and continue to hold an 86 and 88 averages even after finishing up this last semester which they were informed was one of the most difficult semesters of the ten. Daniel finished up his third semester in the Nursing Program with an average of 89. We are so very proud of our children because they each have remained faithful to God despite the trails and temptations they have faced and how they continue to press forward considering they have had all their classes in Spanish. Learning a career is difficult in itself but when one has to study it in another language it makes things just a little more challenging and stressful at times. We are so thankful to each and every one of you that have taken upon yourself to pray and intercede for them — their schooling, their safety and above all their faithfulness to God!

Despite the Covid-19 fear, the church is almost back to its normal attendance while we continue with the safely precautions required by the state. We are so thankful that as of yet no one in our immediate family has gotten the virus, but some of our church members tested positive with very slight symptoms. For a number of months we were holding two services to comply to the rules of social distancing on Sundays, but these last few weeks we have returned back to the one service.

Please continue to pray for the salvation of the drug lords and those who steal and kill for illegally harvesting and selling pine trees. We reminisce at times how things these last 10 years have changed so drastically and yet God continues to protect and guide us through these times of uncertainty. With the increase of violence we continue to be part of many funerals with the hopes of reaching and ministering to the grieving families.

Thank you for your continued love, prayers and support! We close and pray that this coming year of 2021 will turn any heartaches you might have had to face with an overwhelming senses of God's presence, provision and protection. Let us all be mindful during these times to be faithful to His CALLING that He has placed on our individual lives in the fear of the Lord and may we be kept in the power of His might.
