Yesterday for example, we finished service at 1:00, spent time visiting the people until around 2:00, invited some over for a meal which they left around 6:00, cleaned up the kitchen, then around 6:30 a lady (from another church) brought over her two teenagers to be part of Daniels youth activity, and then from that point until 9:30 we were ministering to her and prayerfully she left encouraged knowing that God can turn all situations around.

How time just flies by for us —between all the demands that is required of the ministry here in San Juanito, visiting the kids out in Chihuahua, and making trips to El Paso for one reason or another . . .our time just quickly passes by! It seems that we just sent out an update and then we realize that two months have rushed by. We cannot express to you how important all your prayers have been for the ministry and for our family. We are always amazed how God has taken each of our children through challenges and how they continue to press towards the calling that God has placed on their lives despite the many tears, frustrations, and discouragements they have encountered throughout their careers. Knowing that Crystal and Cassandra have completed 6 years and Daniel 4 years, is just the result of all the prayer warriors that have taken upon themselves to intercede and pray for our children for which we are so ever grateful to!



We have attached LED bulbs on our 8 foot cross that we made years ago. Since one of the two main roads that go through our town is in the front of our house, we have always tried to have it lit up at night. For the reason being that just incase someone is fleeing for their lives for one reason or another, or someone is contemplating taking their life or the life of someone else, that they will see the cross and reflex for a moment on what Jesus Christ did for them and that there is Hope and Security in Him!



Praise Reports:

- We have started once again the studies in Yeposo and Talayotes in order to encourage the brothers to remain faithful to their commitment to Jesus Christ and for those that have fallen back into the things of the world, we are earnestly trying to help them see their sin of rejecting Christ and to nurture them back to God.
- Things have been quiet between the drug cartels – it appears that each are remaining on their own territory and for this reason it has allowed us to go back into the communities where we started in 1996. Thank you for your prayers!
- Crystal, Cassandra, and Daniel continue to advance in their skills:

Prayer Requests:

- For Crystal, Cassandra and Daniel as to what place will be opened for them to do their one year of residency starting in August. We are praying that wherever God sends them that they will be kept safe and that they will remain faithful to their relationship with God. Also Lord willing, that the hospital will offer some sort of housing so we won't have to rent a place for each; that is if they are assigned to serve at different areas.
- Continued healing for the families whom have lost loved ones by the hands of the drug lords: families such as Emma Zamarron - three sons, Baltazar Castillo - a son, Macario Castillo - a son, Lupe Cruz - a son, Rosa Castillo - a son, Clemente Banda - a son, Rosa Castillo - a son, Ramona Barrera - two sons and a husband, Maria - two sons, Eber Perez - a brother and his brother's son (his nephew), and the list goes on and on.
- For Moises (17 years old) Javier (32) Angel (35) that have been kidnapped in November 2021, and forced to work for the drug lords. There are many more, but these are the ones that we know personally.
- Continued prayers for Omar, Luis, Ramon, Amelia, Teodoro, Nancy, Anselmo, Manuela, Graciela, Estela, Lupe, Francisca, Adan, Nidia, Antonio, Enriqueta, Rosa, Sisto, Isabel, and others that have fallen away from their faith in God and many have succumbed to the sin of drinking in abundance which have resulted in fights between family members and those that they were close to, which in turn has produced hatred. (Here people don't drink to be sociable they drink for one purpose . . . to get drunk.) It always saddens us to see men that are drunks but these last few years more and more ladies have also chosen this sin and their kids are greatly being affected. Years ago, many after giving their hearts to Jesus Christ, stopped drinking all together and have never fell back into it but a few of them have. They stopped attending church during the Covid-19, and fell back into this stronghold of alcohol.
